Symphony No. 35 in D major, K. 385, "Haffner"

Fourth Movement (Presto)

1. Measure 134 through measure 197.

Schoenberg

Verklärte Nacht [Transfigured Night] for String Orchestra, Opus 4

1. Measure 310 (12 measures after Rehearsal Letter P) [poco più mosso/etwas bewegter] to the downbeat of measure 344 (15 measures after Rehearsal Letter S).

R. Strauss

Don Juan for Orchestra, Opus 20

1. Beginning to downbeat of five measures before Rehearsal Letter D.

3. Sight-Reading – may be requested.
